



ETEN Conference April 2021

UC SYD is in the process of planning the ETEN conference due to take place 22-24 April 2021 in Esbjerg. We take various scenarios into account depending on the COVID-19 situation so that as a member you can confidently register using the link on the website www.ucsyd.dk/eten

The following scenarios are possible:

1. UC SYD holds the conference as per normal with a minimum of 120 participants
2. UC SYD holds the conference as a blended conference if a minimum of 70 external participants take part. Activities are adjusted to the COVID-19 situation, meaning that the social activities and the conference dinner will be a little different. UC SYD adjusts the conference programme once the decision to hold a blended conference has been made by 1 March 2021. Ticket prices will be the same as for scenario 1 because it is relatively more expensive to run a conference for fewer people. TIGs will be run with an online connection so that members who are unable to travel because of COVID-19 restrictions can attend the thematic discussions – free of charge.
3. 100 % virtual conference – the TIGs plan virtual thematic discussions by themselves. Participation is free of charge.

Registration deadline is 21 February 2021. On 1 March 2021 ETENs board together with UC SYD decide which of the above scenarios apply. If scenario 3 is chosen, all paid conference fees are refunded 100%. If a participant is unable to travel because of COVID-19 (for instance if their institution will not allow travel abroad) the registration fee is refunded 100% even if the conference is held as per scenario 1 or 2. Such cases must however be documented to UC SYD for instance in the form of a letter from the participant's institution or reference to government guidelines.
